Chronology for first NCCPP grants round

7 May 2004 the Prime Minister announced a new National Community Crime Prevention Programme

23 May 2004 the grants were advertised in all major papers and in the main regional papers the following weekend.

By 30 June 2004 over 180 applications were received with requests for funding amounting to more than \$40 million.

On 22 July the Advisory Group met to consider the applications and to make recommendations to the Minister for Justice and Customs.

On 28 July 2004 the Minister for Justice and Customs decided the successful applications under the Partnership stream.

On 29 July 2004 Departmental letters were sent advising applicants of their success.

On 30 July 2004 the successful recipients of grants under the Partnership stream were publicly announced.

On 16 August 2004 the Minister for Justice and Customs decided the successful applications under the Indigenous Safety and the Community Safety streams.

On 14 September 2004 Departmental letters were sent advising applicants of their success.

On 15 September 2004 the successful recipients of grants under the remaining two streams, Indigenous Safety and Community Safety were publicly announced.
