



## Applying for Import Permission SPECIFIED PURPOSES - AMMUNITION

### Specified Purposes Test - Ammunition

Under this test, importers may import ammunition or components of ammunition as part of a contract to supply the ammunition, or component of ammunition, to a person outside Australia, in a manner that will not contravene Australia's international obligations.

### Import Conditions

The importation can only take place if there is a contract in place to supply the ammunition.

The supply of the ammunition can not contravene Australia's international obligations.

The ammunition must be exported within a specific time frame, as mentioned in the import permit. If the ammunition is not been exported by this time, it must be destroyed.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be made in writing to the Attorney-General's Department.

### Required Supporting Documentation

- 1. Completed application form including details of the articles to be imported, the reason for importation and the date of import.
- 2. Evidence of contract in force:
  - ⇒ Purchase order; or
  - ⇒ Copy of a contract.
- 3. Statement the supply will not contravene Australia's international obligations:
  - ⇒ Statutory Declaration.
- 4. Evidence of export:
  - ⇒ Copy of export permit.
